




The last three pieces in this collection were made at the 4S Conference in Seattle, Washington, held September 3-6, 2025.





Inexpensive microprocessors are usually slow.



A simple and cheap microprocessor would not do a wonderful job of creating content that is appealing enough to steal eyeballs.

The Internet fosters the emergence of a third class of use: applications and data that are stored at some other computer someplace, prepared and owned by unrelated individuals or organizations, that anyone can access through this pervasive, inexpensive set of connections, the "connection co-op."

While this last category is amazing even as it is today, and probably has great promise going into the future, can it really effectively replace the first two classes of use? I don't think so.

Research Says

- Cognitive behavioral therapy for IBS may lead to real relief from physical symptoms.
- People with IBS who did 20–60 minutes of moderate-to-hard physical activity three to five times a week had reduced symptoms after 12 weeks.

MISSING LINK

It's not just stress with IBS develops. It could be brought on by an imbalance of bacteria in the intestines. Or it could be due to a glitch in communication between the gut and the brain. People with IBS may have more sensitive colons than others, says Jeffrey MD, a gastroenterologist at Mayo Clinic in Jacksonville, Florida. "People with IBS have a different gut microbiome," he says. "It's not clear why."
